### **RGAC Update**

- VISION – Find some way to house and maintain a regional data set
- Moving along slowly trying to prioritize which data layers should actually be regional and then streamline the attributes accordingly.
  - Will be looking at the combined Data List that we have been compiling and try to determine how to format data sets for everyone's use. There is a lot of duplication on the list, so looking at how to departmentalize the list for each group.

## *Subcommittees*

### **Addressing – Travis Tyson and Jay Young - Presentation**

- Demonstrated the application for all layers including schools, parks, EMS, Medical Facilities, City Government, Airports, Cemetarys and Military locations.
- New points will be located based on incoming address assignments. The work flow in Nampa has proven effective, Travis receives copies of all incoming permits to verify address/business locations.
- Currently housed on same server as Centerline data.
- Still working on how to track temporary addresses.
- An OFFICIAL ROADNAME LIST is still a work in progress. Should come from the centerline file not an unattached excel spreadsheet. The question then becomes, Who is responsible for updating the list...the centerline file needs to be cleaned out and added to.

### **Hydrography – Forrest Smith**

- GOAL – For IDWR to be able to push out as official dataset.
- The Data has been replicated and is available for editing. Committee will defer to editors for input.

## *New Business*

### **PRESENTATION – Outfall Data Capture – Craig Tarter**

- Using GPS to locate, gather data (conditions, etc.) and take photographs of outfall points for MS4 Permit. We are using ARCPad to create and filling in all the information available to edit each point. Fairly close to completing this project, we are cleaning up typographical errors and setting up for monitoring.

### **2010 SDC Goals Status**

- GIS Data Matrix was merged with SIG and other lists for RGAC to determine regional information and standardize the list. Still need more information.
- SDC History – Craig demonstrated the layout of the historical data on the SDC Website. There are some gaps, if anyone has any historical information to add to the list please e-mail it to Kristi Watkins at [watkinsk@cityofnampa.us](mailto:watkinsk@cityofnampa.us). Ross Dodge will see if he can find a document that shows a history of origination of the GIS group. We are also reviewing the list on the website of members in good standing as it appears to be outdated.
- Everyone seems to think that the SIG-SDC joint meeting was a good idea and that future (quarterly) meetings would be beneficial.

- The plan of action is to continue with updating data list and upgrading communications by providing quarterly (?) meetings to share ideas with all members.
